Applicable agencies will be intimated to deposit ₹1,25,000/- plus 18% GST for Qualitative Appraisal. Applicants are advised to thoroughly review the **DDU-GKY 2.0** guidelines and procedures before submitting their application.

Under DDU-GKY 2.0 scheme, agencies are encouraged to train and place candidates according to the skill gap existing in different sectors preferably in the following Sectors like **Tourism & Hospitality, Apparel Made-Ups & Home Furnishing, Beauty & Wellness, Aerospace & Aviation, Constructions, Electronics & Hardware, IT-ITeS, Healthcare, Food Processing, Retail.** 

1. Details to consider while putting up proposals:

a. Eligible agencies can apply for short-term courses ranging from a minimum of 576 hours, spanning 3 to 4.5 months in duration.

b. Priority will be granted to PIAs with a proven record in placements and those operating training centers within Mizoram.

c. Preference will be given to proposals from eligible PIAs covering Persons with disabilities (PWDs) candidates.

Proposals must be submitted by <u>18 June</u>, 2025 Applications received after this deadline will not be considered in this appraisal round. Additionally, any incomplete proposals will be rejected without review.

The entire application process is conducted online, eliminating the need to submit hard copies of documents. Proposal submission, screening, and selection will be carried out strictly in accordance with the guidelines and regulations established by MORD.
